1. I do not believe that the correct process has been followed for rezoning of this scale and the public has not been giving he opportunity for consultation.

- 2. There is no design information available on the impact of the re-zoning on the community and environment.
 - a. The Silverstream roundabouts are extremely busy intersections. Entering the roundabout from the south end of Kiln Street is already hazardous, let alone with the additional traffic from a new residential development. Traffic flow / management will be severely impacted in the southern suburbs of Upper Hutt and access to SH2 will be significantly degraded.
 - b. There is insufficient infrastructure (shops, schools, doctors, carparking at shops and at train station) to support the rezoning, nor is the space to provide the required infrastructure.
- 3. There is no indication of cost to the ratepayers of Upper Hutt.

The reasons for my support or opposition are:

- The actual need for housing in Upper Hutt
 - o The district plan <u>already provides</u> for sufficient housing
 - This development is not necessary for Upper Hutt's anticipated future growth
- I believe in the integrity and transparency of democratic processes.
 - This process (related to rezoning of the Spur) should have been initially notified publicly, and given the scale of the change and the impact to Upper Hutt, is quite surprising that it being included at this stage.
 - It is my understanding from a recent LGOIMA that UHCC and GTC have worked together to ensure the approach has happened this way, which in my opinion is not a very good look
 - The impacts of this proposed development have not been given in full to the community so that they can make an informed decision on the benefits and costs of it
 - o The community have <u>not explicitly been asked</u> if they want development on the hills above Silverstream and Pinehaven the process so far has been piecemeal
 - o Furthermore, this should be a private plan change, paid for by the submitter. Council should not be spending ratepayer funds to facilitate a private development
- Climate change implications on infrastructure
 - It has become obvious in recent years that building on hills is unsafe and expensive.
 For example, the slips in Stokes Valley. We cannot expect to engineer our way out of climate change.
 - Severe weather events are forecast to be more frequent and severe
 - UHCC ratepayers should not have to fund, maintain and eventually repair infrastructure on hills that will be at this level of risk
 - The development on the hills will be totally car dependent, leading to unavoidable emissions from those forced to drive every day
- The looming rates burden and the need to spend public funds effectively and efficiently

- As mentioned above, it is not fair to ask ratepayers to contribute towards a development that will be a net rates burden on all of us
- There are better opportunities to build more cheaper or resilient infrastructure for other developments (e.g. St Pats, Racecourse)
- Stormwater management and flood control
 - The Parliamentary Commissioner for the Environment has written to UHCC and HCC expressing concerns around the flood maps that are out of date and not fit for purpose
- Traffic management and impact on supporting services
 - Development on the hills of Silverstream will double the demand on Silverstream's roading infrastructure
 - The intersection of Field and Kiln, and those coming from Kiln, will be impacted severely (it can often take a few minutes for one car to get through the intersection, and there will be an additional 2000 using the intersection every day)
 - This will also mean servicing this area by bus will be infeasible, as the bus will be unreliable
 - Silverstream's roads are already full with those parking to catch the train every morning

1. <u>Traffic Congestion:</u> The proposed rezoning and subsequent development would significantly exacerbate existing traffic congestion issues in Upper Hutt, particularly in the Silverstream and Pinehaven areas. The submission fails to provide a comprehensive traffic management plan to address the increased vehicle load on already strained local roads and access routes to State Highway 2. This concern is not merely theoretical; it directly impacts local residents. For instance, exiting our property onto Kiln Street has become increasingly challenging and dangerous due to parked cars and increased traffic volume. The proposed development would only amplify these issues, making simple tasks like leaving one's property both time-consuming and hazardous. This personal experience

underscores the urgent need for a thorough traffic impact assessment and mitigation strategy, which the current submission lacks.

- 2. <u>Infrastructure Strain:</u> Current infrastructure, including water supply, sewage systems, and local roads, is inadequate to support the proposed population increase. The submission lacks detailed plans for necessary infrastructure upgrades, risking overload and potential system failures.
- 3. <u>Lack of Social and Well-being Facilities</u>: The proposal fails to adequately address the need for additional social infrastructure such as schools, medical facilities, and recreational areas. Existing amenities are already under pressure, and further development without these considerations will negatively impact community well-being.
- 4. <u>Environmental Impact</u>: The proposed development would lead to significant deforestation and loss of natural habitats crucial for maintaining the area's ecological balance. The submission does not provide sufficient measures for managing erosion, sediment discharge, and other environmental impacts resulting from large-scale earthworks and development.
- 5. <u>Inconsistency with Planning Instruments</u>: The proposal does not align with the objectives of the National Policy Statement on Urban Development (NPS-UD) to create well-functioning urban environments. It is also inconsistent with the Upper Hutt City Council's Long Term Plan (LTP) for planned, sustainable growth and infrastructure development. Specifically:
 - a) National Policy Statement on Urban Development (NPS-UD): The proposal does not fully align with the objectives of the NPS-UD, which came into effect on 20 August 2020. Specifically:
 - Objective 1 of the NPS-UD aims for "well-functioning urban environments that enable all people and communities to provide for their social, economic, and cultural wellbeing, and for their health and safety, now and into the future."
 - The submission fails to demonstrate how the proposed development would create a well-functioning urban environment, particularly given the lack of planning for social infrastructure and the potential strain on existing services.

- b) Upper Hutt City Council's Long Term Plan (LTP) 2021-2031: The proposed zoning change appears inconsistent with the planned, staged approach to growth outlined in the LTP. Specifically:
 - The LTP identifies specific areas for growth and includes planned infrastructure upgrades to support this growth.
 - The submission seeks to accelerate development in an area not currently prioritized in the LTP, potentially disrupting the planned sequence of infrastructure investments.

• For example, the LTP mentions upgrades to the Silverstream bridge and Pinehaven reservoir, but these are planned for years 4-10 and 11-20 respectively, which may not align with the timeline proposed in the submission.

This process (related to rezoning of the Spur) should have been initially notified publicly, and given the scale of the change and the impact to Upper Hutt, is quite surprising that it being included at this stage. The full impacts of this proposed development have not been given in full to the community, so that they can make an informed decision on the benefits and costs of it. This should be a private plan change, paid for by the submitter. Council should not be spending ratepayer funds to facilitate a private development.

It has become obvious in recent years that building on hills is unsafe and expensive. For example, the slips in Stokes Valley. The possible slips on the hills could affect the current Silverstream infrastructure including public transport network.

Stormwater management and flood control

The Parliamentary Commissioner for the Environment has written to UHCC and HCC expressing concerns around the flood maps that are out of date and not fit for purpose. Such a drastic change in landuse of the surrounding hills could increase the risk of flooding on the current Silverstream/Pinehaven houses and infrastructure

Traffic management and impact on supporting services

Development on the hills of Silverstream will double the demand on Silverstream's roading infrastructure There would need to be significant additional investment of roading and public transport to support additional houses in the area. The intersection of Field and Kiln, and those coming from Kiln, will be impacted severely (it can often take a few minutes for one car to get through the intersection, and there will be an additional 2000 using the intersection every day).

The additional traffic and trucks on the road would also put pressure on the Silverstream bridge. This will possibly need improvement.

All the additional traffic (during and after development) will mean servicing this area by bus will be infeasible, as the bus will be unreliable

Silverstream's roads are already full with those parking to catch the train every morning.

I have personally been impacted by the water shortages that our area has been facing and question the suitability of a housing development that, under new rules, can put an additional 3-5000 houses to be reliant on the same insufficient infrastructure.

- The location of the proposed development it too far from established public transport hubs. Given the terrain involved it is unlikely to encourage cycling or walking to the train station.
- Traffic management interface with the existing State Highway 2 at the Silverstream Bridge.

The Process

- I am highly concerned submitters of #162 GTC are attempting the proposed plan change 50 to bypass a private plan change process which would provide the public the detailed design information and allow the public to know what they are submitting for or against.
- I am also aware that the Mayor and the CE have given commitments to the developer that were not supported by UHCC due process. I feel that there is currently a complete lack of accountability by the leadership of the UHCC to the ratepayer on this issue. Concerned at the lack of consultation with Maori.

Proposed Plan Change 50 – Rural Chapter Review (PC50)

I am a person who has an interest in the proposal that is greater than the interest the general public has because I have been living in Silverstream for 49 years and anticipate that the proposed plan change will lead to traffic congestion on routes into, out of, and within Silverstream village, increase the likelihood of flooding particularly at the railway underpasses, and exceed the capacity of local schools, shops and services.

I oppose the submission of:

 Guildford Timber Company Limited, Silverstream Forest Limited and the Goodwin Estate Trust (Submitter Number 162)

The particular parts of the submission I oppose are:

I oppose the Guildford Timber Company's submission on Plan Change 50 seeking to have the proposed development of GTC's land included in the Fast-track approvals legislation thereby short-circuiting the opportunity for consideration and comment by members of the public who stand to be significantly affected by the proposed rezoning of land from Rural to General Residential zone.

The reasons for my opposition are:

- The proposed rezoning will allow up to 2040 new houses to be built in an area which currently provides a 'green surround' to Silverstream and Pinehaven and offers ecological and recreational benefits to those communities.
- The scale of the proposed rezoning is such that upgrading infrastructure such as roading, water and electricity supply, and stormwater drainage and flood prevention

measures will require considerable investment, but the submitter has offered no information on how this will be delivered and who will fund it.

- The proposed rezoning is focused on delivering additional houses but many of them
 will not be located within walking distance of necessary community facilities such as a
 school, a supermarket and public transport.
- For there to be genuine public consultation, people living in Silverstream, Pinehaven and the vicinity of Blue Mountains Road need to be given access to much more information regarding the plans which Guildford Timber Company have developed before a decision is made on the proposed rezoning.
