



UPPER HUTT DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE UNCONTESTED APPLICATIONS DECISION

Authority

The functions, powers and duties as the District Licensing Committee are delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and Inspector, in respect of the following applications:

- »- an application for a licence;
- »- an application for a manager's certificate;
- »- an application for renewal of a licence or manager's certificate.

Statutory Provisions

- Section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2013
- Council resolution dated 13 November 2013
- There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place

Summary of Evidence

Reports from Police, Medical Officer of Health, and an Inspector appointed under the Act do not oppose the granting of these applications. Based on the information provided on the complete files, it has been determined not to convene public hearings.

Evaluation of Evidence

These applications have been considered on the basis of the reports received where no objections have been raised, and noted that there has also been no public objection, therefore there is no reason not to grant these applications.

Decision and Reasons

All reports are satisfactory and no objections have been raised to the granting of these applications, therefore it has been determined that these applications for SPECIAL Licences be granted.
